

Design Competition Criteria

Projects must have been designed while enrolled in an interior design program. Entrants may submit more than one project. A separate entry form and fee must accompany each submission. Fees are \$20 for ASID/IIDA student members/\$30 Non-members.

Projects must be submitted on a compact disc(CD) in PDF format. There is a MAXIMUM of 8 pages allowed per project. Each project must be submitted with four (4) copies on CD.

Project Requirements

Projects MUST include, but are not limited to: Floor Plan(s), Reflective Ceiling Plan(s), Finish selections, Project description (100 word maximum) explaining design concept, and *at least one of the following:* Elevation & Section, Perspective, or Axonometric.

DO NOT INCLUDE YOUR NAME OR SCHOOL NAME ON ANY PART OF YOUR PROJECT! All projects will be previewed to ensure this data is not present. Those projects not adhering to this rule will be disqualified and the entry fee will be reimbursed.

Categories for entry are: Residential, Corporate, Hospitality/Retail, and Institutional. If you have questions about a particular project or assignment please contact Seka Roberts.

All projects must be received by **January 18, 2008** to enter the competition. NO late entries will be accepted.

All entries will be judged the week of January 21-February 1, 2008, by licensed Interior Designers from the State of Florida.

Winners will be announced and Prizes will be awarded on during the Student Day Awards Ceremony.

Best Overall: \$500
Category First Place: \$200 each
Category Runner-Up: \$100 each

All competitors are encouraged to bring their project to display in the Student Day Gallery. Please indicate on our entry form whether you wish to exhibit. Due to limited space, Gallery space is a first-come, first serve basis.
